General Comment

DAIMLAS over the last 3 years has become the #1 AI Ecosystem Builder expert platform globally. We built the Massachusetts, New Jersey, Washington DC, and California AI ecosystem platforms by DAIMLAS. Our 1st step is to "map the AI ecosystems". in this process we realized that in a fully functioning AI ecosystem, the AI Labs and AI centers of excellence connected to Academia are the highest value resource for stakeholders to participate. They create pathways into AI. As such, we recommend that NAIRR be fully anchored in Academia. For America to stay ahead of China in the global AI rankings, we must increase participation in AI for all Americans and that can only be done at scale and merit via Academia. AI Labs and AI CoE's need to create "alliance programs" for the local stakeholders to participate. While DAIMLAS has come to be known as the #1 AI ecosystem platform globally, we believe that it is our duty to support every school in America to create academic pathways into AI. At the universities where NAIRR is introduced, the school must be vigilant on who is access the AI resources, and they must be accompanied by an American faculty or researcher.
